Objectives

**Promotion of the photographers and their work,

Theme

Fixed theme since the first edition of the competition, “**Vie di Fuga**”, gives large interpretive possibilities. The concept of escape offers different meanings, for the visual arts the reference to the perspective escape of the Renaissance is immediate; at the same time the escape is for some people the attempt to get out, to escape the everyday life, a physical and mental journey. Ethical, political, passionate acceptations...

Art Director

The Artistic Direction is left to Ms. Giovanna Fiorenza, director and art promoter.

Jury

Besides the Artistic Direction, the jury will be chaired by a president and made up of exponents of the International Cultural Scene, it will select the three final works and will nominate, under unappealable judgment, the first prize winner. Between all the received photographs, the best works will be selected and will form the corpus of the exhibition.

Prizes

First Prize: € 500.00, Second and Third: mentions.

The winning entry will be used for promotional purposes, in any shape or form, at the discretion of the organising body which will obtain the respective rights of use.

- Written report: 15 lines max.
- Specify: surname and name of the author, title, year and realisation technics.
- Artistic/professional profile or Resume.
- Acquaintance for the transfer/assignment of the work, which authorises the organising body to exhibit or publish the image in any shape or form.
- Declaration of authenticity of the photograph.
- Every photo should show on the back name and surname of the photographer.

Technical features

Paper copy of the photograph in format cm. 20x30, in black and white or colour, from negative, slide or digital.
